## Reminder—Census Forms in the Mail This Month

Census forms will be mailed this month. When you receive your census questionnaire, please take a few minutes to fill it out and mail it back. All responses are used for statistical purposes only and are strictly confidential. The Village receives its share of income, use, and MFT taxes on a per capita basis. The 2010 census will affect how much is allocated to Sugar Grove, local agencies, and other taxing bodies for the next ten (10) years. Completing the census questionnaire does not increase your taxes however it does ensure that the correct share is allocated to our community. Please, do your part to achieve an accurate count and promptly return your questionnaire.

## Recycling and Refuse Reminders



Weekly curbside garbage and recycling collection is provided for all Village residents. All containers should be at the street by 5:30 a.m. on your pick up day. Remember that drivers and routes change so even if your “normal” driver generally arrives later in the day, please have your containers about by 5:30 a.m. to ensure that your refuse and recycling is picked up.

Refuse containers (cans or plastic bags) may be up to 32 gallons and weigh no more than 50 lbs. One (1) large item is also allowed per week; excluding "white goods" as defined by the Illinois E.P.A. as refrigerators, ranges, water heaters, freezers, air conditioners, humidifiers, stoves, clothes dryers, ovens, dishwashers, water coolers, heat pumps, chillers, furnaces, and boilers. When disposing of a large or odd shaped item please call Waste Management as there may be special preparation instructions, such as a large piece of glass or a mirror needing to be taped.

The following are "non-collection" holidays, when the holiday falls during the week. If a holiday falls on the weekend the collection schedule will not be affected. If a holiday falls on a regular pickup day, service will be delayed by 1 (one) day.

## What is Water Reclamation?



Water reclamation is the process used to remove pollutants from wastewater thereby “reclaiming” the water and returning clean water to the environment. Fox Metro and the Village of Sugar Grove work together to provide the water reclamation service for the Village. Both entities own, operate, and maintain a portion of the sanitary sewer system, the system that collects and ultimately reclaims the wastewater produced throughout the Village.

The wastewater produced by homes and businesses flows through private sewer pipes to sewer lines, lift stations, and pumping facilities that are owned and maintained by Sugar Grove. This flow is then conveyed to Fox Metro Water Reclamation District (FMWRD). FMWRD treats the wastewater using a process that surpasses Federal and State set standards so that the water can safely be returned to the environment.

Sugar Grove and Fox Metro began their water reclamation partnership in December, 1999. Prior to that the Village owned and operated its own sewage treatment facility. This partnership was formed to replace the aging and near capacity Sugar Grove facility. At that time the cost to modernize and expand the facility was estimated to be approximately \$12-\$15 million. However, the cost to connect to the Fox Metro Water Reclamation District, including rehabilitation of the Village’s sewer collection system and demolition of the current treatment plant, was estimated to be just \$6 million.
